The scholarship for outstanding students application will be given to those students. To apply for other scholarships download the application form from the school website. Application form and required documents shall be submitted to your department office, which will forward your applications to the Extracurricular Activities Section of Student Affairs Office. The final decisions will be made by the Scholarship Committee.
2. **Only supporting documents from the previous semester shall be submitted; those from other semesters will not be accepted.**
3. Each student is allowed to apply for one scholarship only. If students are eligible for more than one scholarship the Scholarship Committee will discuss which one to grant, and which one to withdraw.
